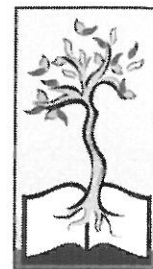




First Presbyterian Preschool's

Roots to Reading



This class fosters emergent literacy skills and concepts. Students engage in hands-on activities that include picture/word association, letter & word recognition, vocabulary development, and phonemic awareness. The curriculum follows the Indiana Academic Standards and utilizes fairy tales and classic children's literature. In this class students will learn to: generate vocabulary using pictures related to literature, recognize beginning sight words, dictate or write and illustrate a story related to one that was read, retell and reenact fairy tales and stories. If your child is a Pre-K student, he/she can participate in this enriching program.

◀Class Time: 12:30-2:30pm on Mondays and Wednesdays

Each class begins with 30 minutes of gross motor activity to give children the ability to concentrate during class.

Children will not have a nap opportunity during this class.

◀Pick Up: Through the alley car line, unless your child is going to Wee Care after class!

◀Teachers: Sheila Fear and Erin Corya

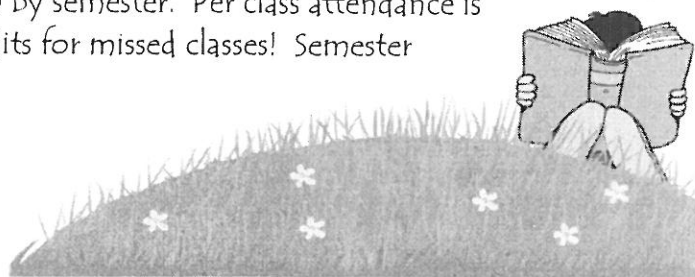
◀Costs:
